

Dress Code

Sharp dressed and neatly groomed ushers and greeters make a good impression on people entering the church for services. It communicates that we care about people and respect the Lord's House. Please follow these guidelines:

The current dress code is business casual for Sunday Mornings and weekend casual for Sunday and Wednesday Nights. Examples of appropriate dress would include:

For men

- Slacks, khaki pants, or crisp jeans
- Open collard shirt or sweater for cold weather. In warmer weather a polo shirt may be worn as long as it is nicely pressed and in overall good appearance.
- A clean and polished pair of shoes. Athletic (tennis) shoes are not appropriate.
- During foul weather outside greeters should wear appropriate outer clothing including gloves and a clean appropriate jacket. Ski jackets, and other casual jackets are not considered appropriate clothing.

For women

- Slacks, khaki pants, or crisp jeans
- Long skirts or dresses touching the top of the knee or below
- Button down shirts which do not show the midriff area, for warmer weather a polo shirt may be worn as long as it is free from logos, neatly pressed and in overall good condition.
- Clean, appropriate shoes; athletic (tennis) shoes are not appropriate.
- During foul weather outside greeters should wear appropriate outer clothing including gloves and a clean appropriate jacket. Ski jackets and other casual jackets are not appropriate for wear
