Diocesan Procedures for New Volunteers

Before you begin volunteering, there are a few things you need to know about Diocesan procedures for volunteers.



Safe Environment Training

- You will need to complete a Safe Environment Training foundation class in person to learn what you can do to keep children and youth safe
- The current foundation program is called "Protecting God's Children for Adults"
- You can find a class and register online by visiting the Safe Environment Training website at www.safeenvironmenttraining.org and clicking on "Register for Classes"
- After completing your foundation class, either every year or every other year (depending on your volunteer position and your volunteering location) you will need to complete a safe environment renewal training class either in person or online

Volunteer Application and Screening

- All volunteers must complete a Volunteer Application and sign a Code of Ethics. This will be maintained at your primary volunteer location.
- You will need to provide contact information for 3-5 references to complete the Volunteer Application. Please notify your references they may be contacted.
- You may be asked to participate in a face to face interview to ensure appropriate placement
